



### Stourport Carnival Terms and Conditions of Entry to Land Parade *(Note new start position)*

1. The decision of the Judges appointed by the carnival is Final
2. All competitors must ensure they indicate the correct class on their entry form. The carnival society (we/us/our) will not be responsible for wrongly classed entries
3. All winners' trophies are returnable, they should be returned to the parade administrator by July 1<sup>st</sup> 2018.
4. We reserve the right to alter, suspend or merge any classes in the competition; refuse entry or withhold prizes at our discretion
5. Competitors judged prior to the parade are required to take part in the parade in order to avoid disqualification
6. All entrants to the appropriate starting points at appropriate times:  
**11am at Redstone Caravan Park for Vehicles and 12pm at Walshes' Meadow for pedestrians**
7. The possession or consumption of alcohol during the parade is strictly forbidden
8. Items which may be a risk to others such as thrown objects or water are not allowed

#### Vehicle Entries:

1. Each vehicle to supply a **MINIMUM of TWO MARSHALS** during the parade to ensure the safety of all entrants and spectators.  
We can provide high Visibility vests.
2. Passengers are NOT allowed to travel to the start point OR leave the finish point on the vehicle
3. For the duration of the parade entrants MUST have adequate safety equipment, such as railings to prevent falls
4. Vehicle owners and insurers must be informed of the vehicles participation in the parade
5. Entrants are restricted to 16 feet high due to cabling in the town centre

#### **Please note: Regulation 100 of Road Vehicles (construction and Use) Act 1986:**

(1) A motor vehicle, every trailer drawn thereby and all parts and accessories of such vehicle and trailer shall at all times be in such condition, and the number of passengers carried by such vehicle or trailer, the manner in which any passengers are carried in or on such vehicle or trailer, and the weight, distribution, packing and adjustment of the load of such vehicle or trailer shall at all times be such, that no danger is caused or is likely to be caused to any person in or on the vehicle or trailer or on a road.

Provided that the provisions of this regulation with regard to the number of passengers carried shall not apply to a vehicle to which the Public Service Vehicles (Carrying Capacity) Regulations 1984 apply.

(2) The load carried by a motor vehicle or trailer shall at all times be so secured, if necessary by physical restraint other than its own weight, and be in such a position, that neither danger nor nuisance is likely to be caused to any person or property by reason of the load or any part thereof falling or being blown from the vehicle or by reason of any other movement of the load or any part thereof in relation to the vehicle.

(3) No motor vehicle or trailer shall be used for any purpose for which it is so unsuitable as to cause or be likely to cause danger or nuisance to any person in or on the vehicle or trailer or on a road.

**Any entry in breach of any above condition will not be judged and will not be allowed to compete in the parade**

#### Disclaimer

All entrants are responsible for their own and their passengers drivers and representatives and agents (the entrants) and will indemnify and hold harmless the Stourport Carnival Society their agents and representatives (the society) against all claims,

demands and liabilities (whether criminal, civil, in contract, tort or otherwise) for all losses, legal costs and other expenses or costs of any nature whatsoever incurred in connection therewith which may be asserted against or suffered by the Society and which relate to:

1. Any injury, loss or damage suffered by the society in connection with the breach, performance or non-performance of Entrants under the terms of the Stourport Carnival Parade terms and conditions of entry
2. The Entrants MUST use the carnival route
3. Any act, neglect or default of the Entrant
4. Breaches in respect of any matter arising from the supply of the Society's services resulting in any successful claim by any third party
